

After Deliverance – “I Am” Statements

Use the following “I Am” statements as daily affirmations or reminders of who you are in Christ during times of reflection and prayer. They are designed to help you align your thoughts with God’s truth about your purpose, calling, and destiny, especially during challenging times after your deliverance session.

1. I am a child of God.

“But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name.” – John 1:12

2. I am fearfully and wonderfully made.

“I will give thanks to You, because I am awesomely and wonderfully made; Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well.” – Psalm 139:14

3. I am chosen and appointed by God.

“You did not choose Me, but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain.” – John 15:16

4. I am created for good works.

“For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.” – Ephesians 2:10

5. I am a light in this world.

“You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden.” – Matthew 5:14

6. I am more than a conqueror.

“But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.” – Romans 8:37

7. I am redeemed and called by name.

“Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name; you are Mine!” – Isaiah 43:1

8. I am a new creation in Christ.

“Therefore if anyone is in Christ, this person is a new creation; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come.” – 2 Corinthians 5:17

9. I am strong and courageous.

“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not be terrified nor dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.” – Joshua 1:9

10. I am equipped for my calling.

“Now may the God of peace...equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ.” – Hebrews 13:20-21

11. I am led by the Spirit of God.

“For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons and daughters of God.” – Romans 8:14

12. I am an ambassador for Christ.

“Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making an appeal through us.” – 2 Corinthians 5:20

13. I am not defined by my past.

“Brothers and sisters, I do not regard myself as having taken hold of it yet; but one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead.” – Philippians 3:13

14. I am strengthened by God.

“I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.” – Philippians 4:13

15. I am filled with divine purpose.

“For I know the plans that I have for you,’ declares the Lord, ‘plans for prosperity and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.” – Jeremiah 29:11

16. I am a co-heir with Christ.

“And if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.” – Romans 8:17

17. I am being transformed daily.

“And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.” – Romans 12:2

18. I am called to bear fruit.

“I am the vine, you are the branches; the one who remains in Me, and I in him bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.” – John 15:5

19. I am destined to glorify God.

“You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God’s own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.” – 1 Peter 2:9

20. I am victorious in Christ.

“But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.” – 1 Corinthians 15:57

21. I am a temple of the Holy Spirit.

“Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?” – 1 Corinthians 6:19

22. I am complete in Christ.

“And in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over every ruler and authority.” – Colossians 2:10

23. I am called for His glory.

“Bring My sons from afar and My daughters from the ends of the earth, everyone who is called by My name, And whom I have created for My glory, Whom I have formed, even whom I have made.” – Isaiah 43:6-7
